

ASC Region 4 Annual Report Saturday, April 21, 2018

- The 2017 Region 4 Construction Management Student Competition and Regional Meeting was held October 25-28. Eleven of the seventeen universities in the seven-state region were represented. In attendance were 24 university faculty and 30 teams totaling 180 students. Events included this year were the ASC Region 4 midyear meeting, a leadership breakfast, faculty research presentations, a keynote speaker, and the 25th annual construction management student competition.
- The 2018 Region 4 Construction Management Student Competition and Regional Meeting will be held on October 24-27, 2018 at the Lied Lodge in Nebraska City, Nebraska. Teams will complete registration by September 23rd. Students from the region will compete in the **five regional divisions** (commercial 1, commercial 2, heavy-civil, and design-build, and specialty). There will be a maximum of 10 teams in each division. A call for papers, presentations, and award nominations for 2018 will also be first sent out on May 1 to all regional schools.

- Region 4 is working to increase both membership and participation from schools in the North Central part of the United States. Currently, there are 17 members in the region up from 14 in 2014. Eleven members were actively involved in the 2014 ASC Region 4 events/competitions and we look to increase that to 13 in the fall of 2018.
- Corporate interest in sponsoring both career fair booths and problem statements for the Region 4 Student Construction Management Competition is quickly growing. Dr. Jongchul Song, Kansas State University, leads the career fair efforts.
- Region 4 oversees ASC's IT Committee. The chair of the IT Committee is Bryan Bowers from Southeast Missouri State University. The IT Committee did not meet at the 2018 Annual Conference. The committee is awaiting ASC reorganization and possible committee charge changes.
